

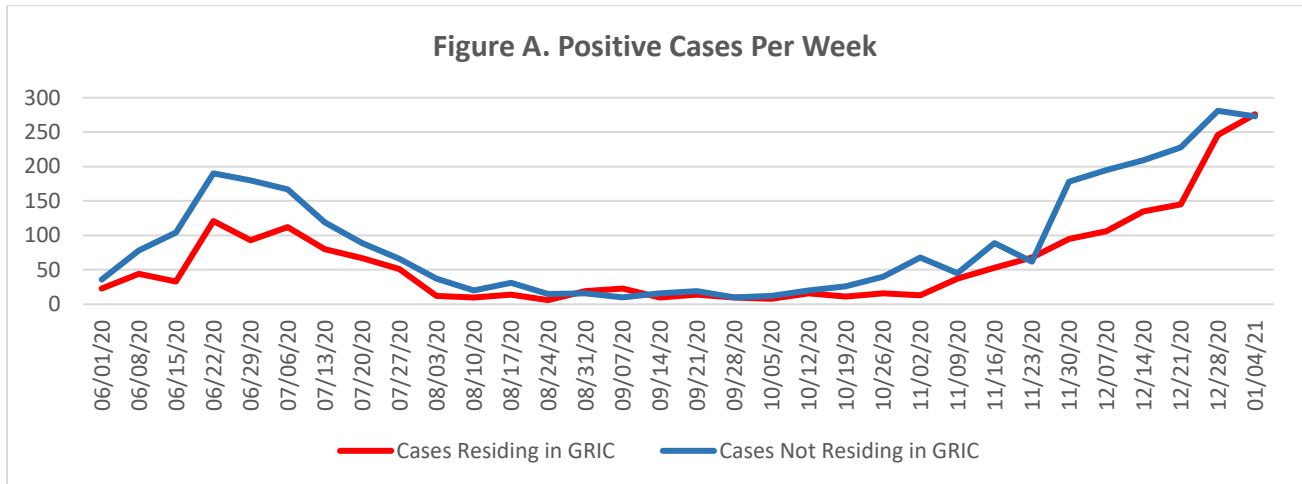
GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY (GRIC) COVID-19 CASES

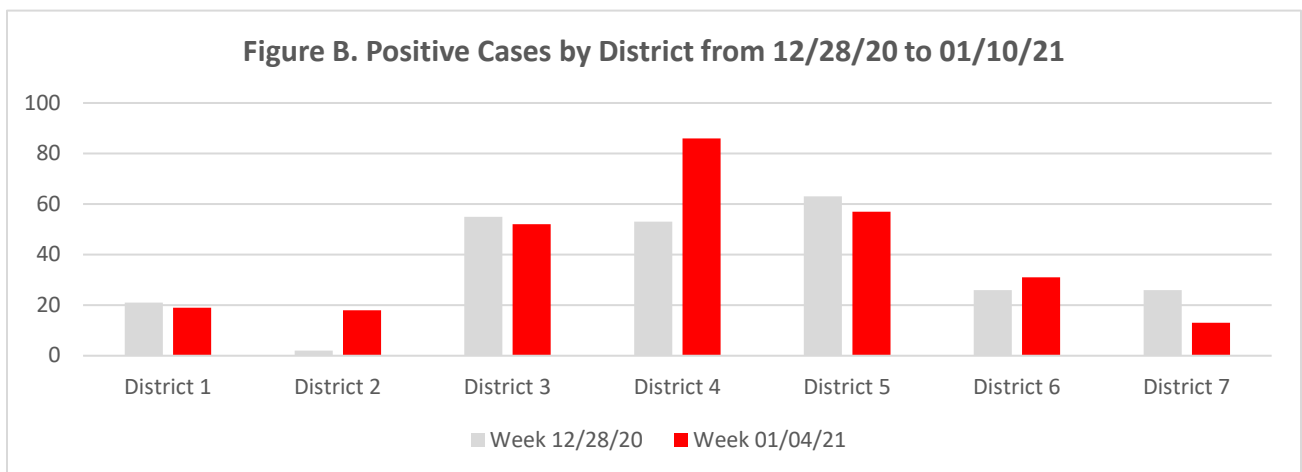


The rate of positive cases continue to increase each week for those residing on and off the Community.

Figure A shows cases begin increasing drastically during the holidays. This large peak is attributed to individuals partaking in family gatherings, holiday events, and/or travel. The week of January 4, 2021, we had a total of 549 cases reported in the Community.



Cases Residing in GRIC – From week 12/28/20 to week 01/04/21, District 2, 4, and 6 each had increases in positive cases. All other Districts had slight decreases, however, each District remains to have high positive case counts.



Tribal Health is strongly urging the Community residents and employees to only leave your home for essential needs. Gatherings and travel increases your chance of getting and spreading Covid.
