



**THE CARING HOUSE NOW ACCEPTING APPOINTMENTS
FOR SAFE IN-PERSON VISITATION BEGINING**

MONDAY, MARCH 22, 2021

Following Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and GRHC Infection Prevention Guidelines,
Gila River Health Care Now Allowing Families to Safely Visit Their Loved Ones at The Caring House.

VISITATION WILL BE ALLOWED:

- 30 minute (scheduled) visit (one visit per resident per day)
- There is a limit of two people per visit (age 12 years or older)
- Visits may be scheduled: Monday – Sunday between 8 am – 5 pm
- Visitation will occur outside the entry of TCH in a designated area
- All visitors will participate in an orientation (via phone) with TCH staff a day prior to the visit

Visitors can make an appointment by calling TCH at (520) 562-7400

A receptionist will assist you by asking:

- **Name of the resident**
- **Date and time you wish to visit**

VISITOR SAFETY GUIDELINES:

- Upon arrival, visitor(s) will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms and issued a mask to be worn during the visit
- A "visitation table" with a clear plexi-glass will provide separation during the visit
- During the visit, residents, and visitors will maintain a safe distance of at least six (6) to eight (8) feet
- Residents will wear a gown, gloves and mask during the visit
- Sanitizer will be provided at the visitation table
- At the end of each visit, staff will sanitize the tables and chairs

IMPORTANT:

- No physical contact between the visitor(s) and the resident will be allowed during the visit
- No eating or drinking is permitted (no outside food is allowed at this time)
- You may bring nonedible items for a resident. We will sanitize before handing it to the Resident and ensure the Resident receives it.
