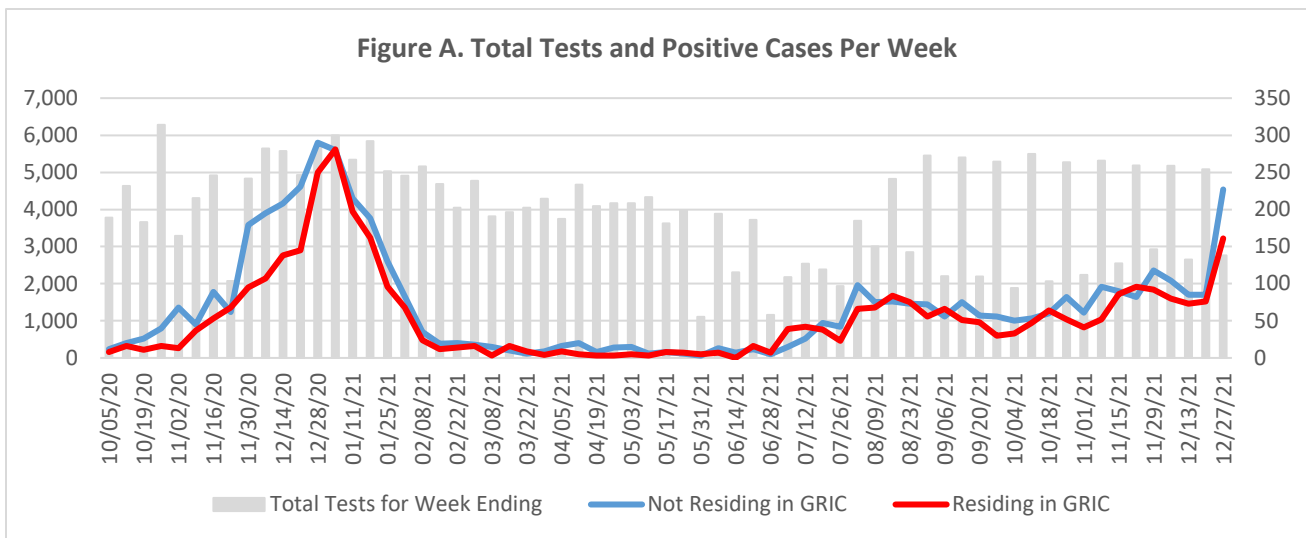

The Tribal Health Department’s data report provides the rate of positive cases for those residing on and off the Community. Since March 2020, 43% of the total cases reside in the GRIC boundaries; and 47% are GRIC tribal enrolled members residing on or off the Community boundaries.



- From 12/6/2021 to 1/2/2022, the Community completed 15,677 COVID-19 tests. There was a total of 891 positive cases reported to the Tribal Health Department. Of the 891 positive cases, 390 or 44% of the cases reside in the Community boundaries. The overall percent test positivity rate for cases residing in the Community is 2.5% during this timeframe. Of the total 891 cases, 49% were GRIC tribal enrolled members and 75% were unvaccinated. Of the total GRIC resident cases, 7% were between the age of 0-4 years, 24% between 3-13 years, and 10% between 14-19 years. Reviewing cases residing in GRIC there was a tremendous spike in cases from week 12/20/21 to week 12/27/21 with an increase of 85 cases. The percent test positivity rate in the last two weeks is at 1.9%. This is an increase of 1.1% from the last report.

The table below shows the cumulative cases per District. District 5 continues to have the largest percentage of their population affected at 38%. The overall percent population affected for GRIC is now at 33% which is an increase of 2% from the last report. The community unfortunately had five additional GRIC tribal enrolled member deaths with the current rate at 114. The number of positive cases residing in GRIC under quarantine is 315 cases.

Cumulative Test Results per Entity

Total employee and urban member surveillance tests completed with Steward Health Care is 178,065 with 1,265 positive cases reported. Test results thru Steward Health Care are provided within the appendices for year 2021. Total tests completed for the Community is 352,621. The cumulative percent positive rate is now 3.6%.

Contact Tracing: Contact tracing shows in these past two weeks individuals have attended family gatherings during Christmas and during the holidays. A few individuals informed the health department they attended a funeral, conference, traveled and sporting game. On average a positive case remains to have at least 5 close contacts. This means for 1 positive case there is potentially 5 individuals that may have contracted the virus and could spread to others.

Vaccination Updates: GRIC Tribal Enrolled Members and Individuals Residing in GRIC

Currently of the GRIC Tribal enrolled members that are 5 years and older – 34% have been fully vaccinated. Of the total GRIC Tribal Enrolled members 33% have been fully vaccinated. This percentage accounts for GRIC tribal enrolled members residing on or off the Community boundaries.

Of the GRIC residents that are 5 years and older – 57% have been fully vaccinated. Of the total GRIC residents (includes all ages) 54% have been fully vaccinated. This percentage accounts for non-GRIC tribal enrolled members residing in the community.

Figure B. Total GRIC Tribal Enrolled Members - Vaccination Status

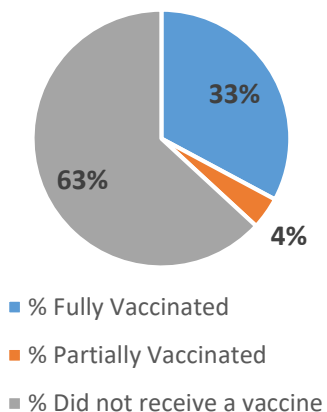
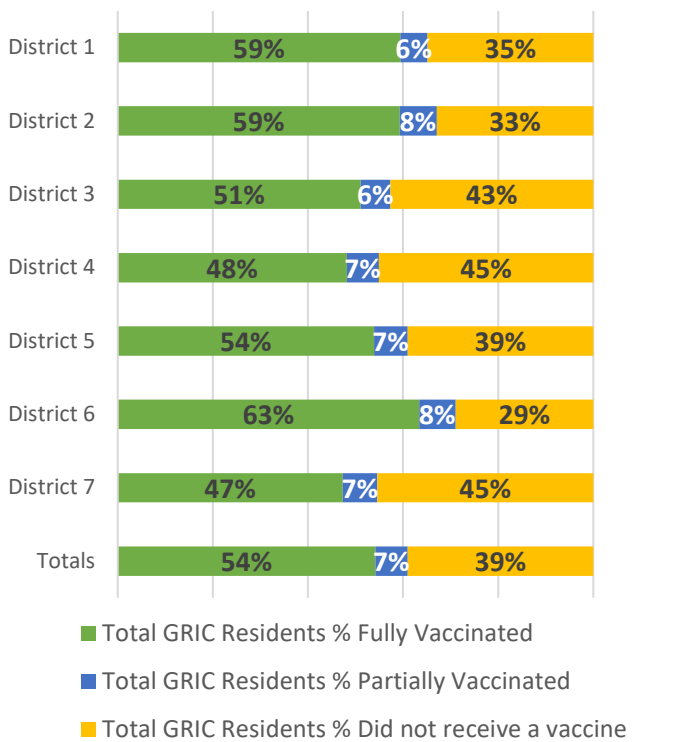
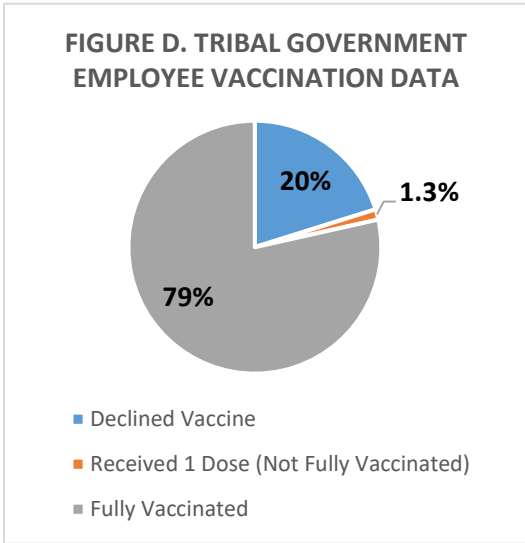


Figure C. Total GRIC Residents - Vaccination Status



Vaccination Updates: GRIC Tribal Government Employees



The current count of number of employees is 1,820. Figure D shows 79% of the tribal government employees are fully vaccinated. The breakdown for each category is as follows: 79% (1,440) are fully vaccinated, 20% (356) declined the vaccine, and 1% (24) received at least 1 dose of the vaccine. Vaccination data per Department can be found in the appendices.

COVID-19 vaccinations have been increasing in the last few weeks with more individuals becoming fully vaccinated. However fully vaccinated individuals that are eligible to receive a 3rd dose/booster is scarce. More fully vaccinated individuals are contracting Covid-19. This is seen more with fully vaccinated individuals not receiving their 3rd dose vaccination/booster. It is important and vital, community members and employees receive their 3rd dose/booster as soon as they are eligible. We are seeing high rates of COVID-19. It is vital Community members get vaccinated and follow all COVID-19 prevention measures to slow the spread of the virus.
