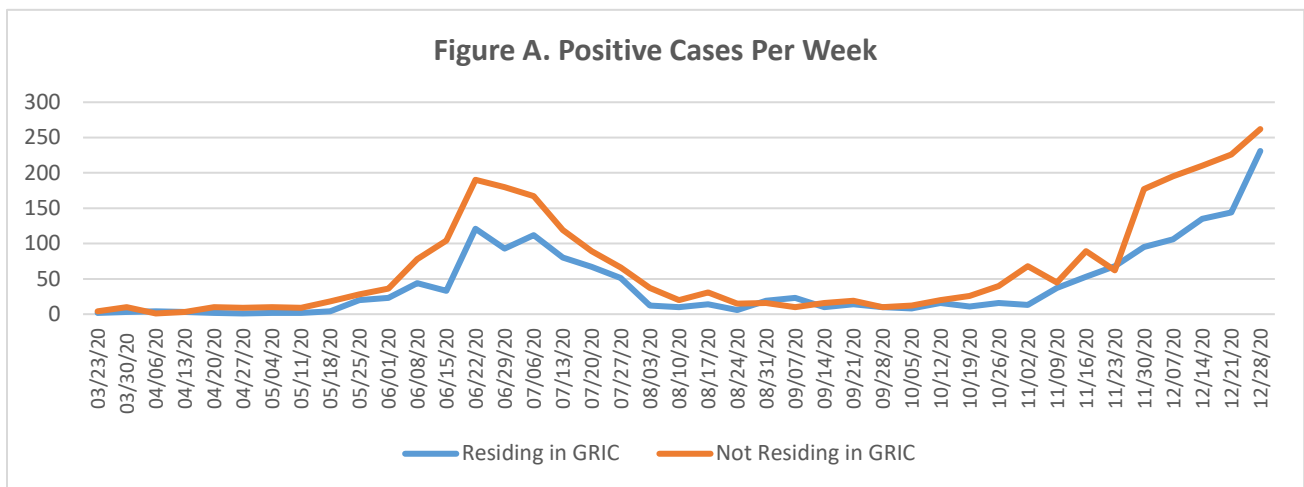

Data Report

The Tribal Health Departments data report shows the rate of positive cases continues to increase each week for those residing on and off the Community. Of the total positive cases since March, 39% reside in the GRIC boundaries and 61% do not reside in the Community. Of the total cases, 42% are GRIC tribal members.

Weekly Review: As shown in Figure A, the week of December 28, 2020, we had our largest total of 493 cases. This is an increase of 123 cases or 33% from the previous week 12/21/20. On January 1, 2021, we had our highest case count of 58 reported in a single day for those residing in the Community.



Monthly Review: There was an increase of 464 cases from November to December for cases residing in GRIC. The data shows the surge beginning November with a tremendous peak in December.

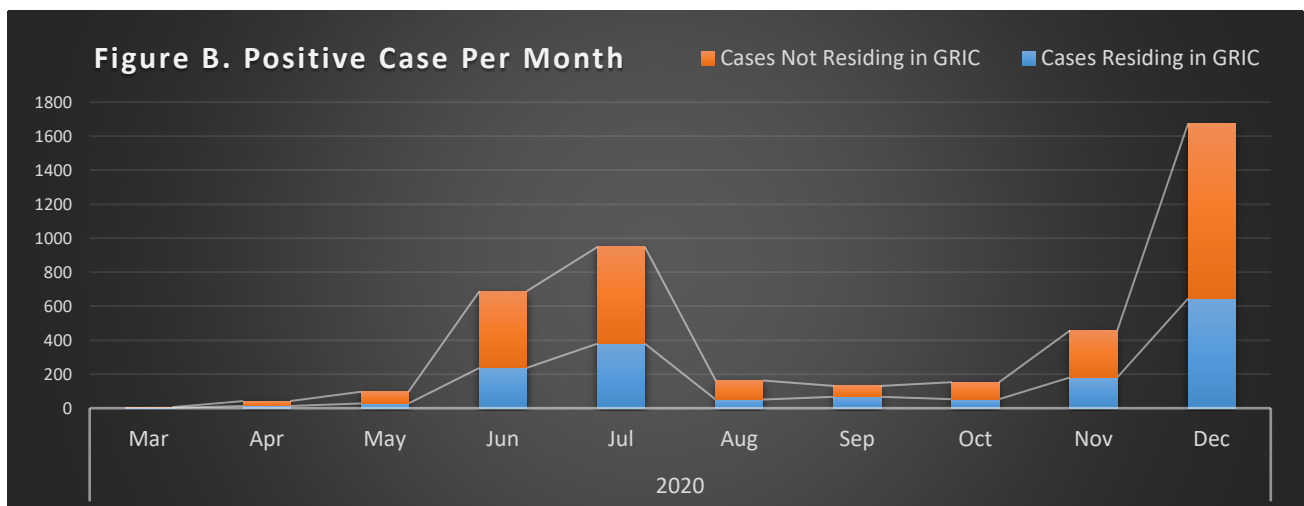


Figure C shows the largest positive case by age is the 31 year olds for the adult population and 14 year olds for the youth population. The majority of the positive cases are between the ages of 21-46 years old.

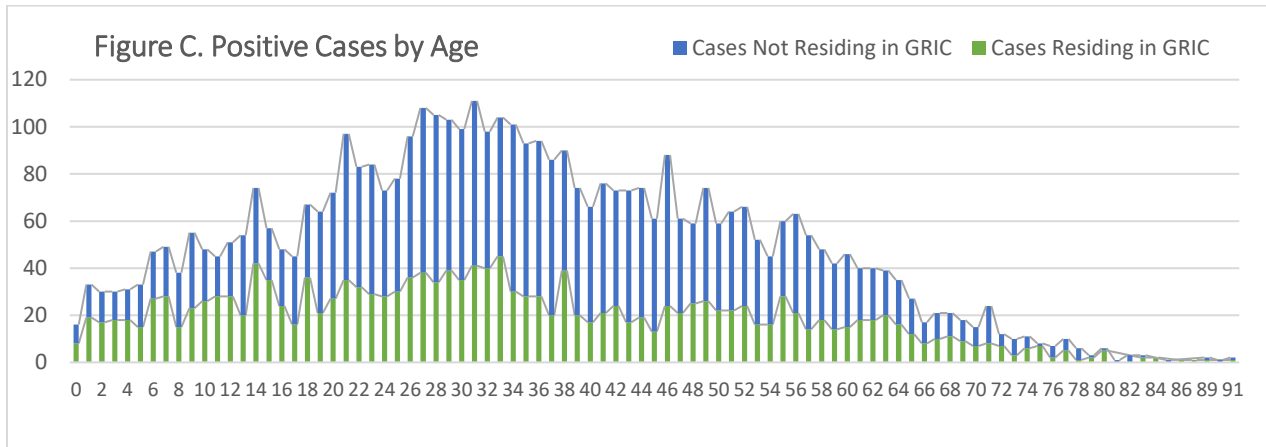


Table 1 provides a snapshot of the positive cases by age and by District. District 7 has the largest percentage affected at 17%. Districts 4, 5, and 6 have the second highest population affected.

The overall percent population affected for GRIC is 13% which is a percent difference of 4 from the last report. At the time of this report, the number of positive cases under quarantine in GRIC was 362 cases. Unfortunately, we had 1 additional GRIC tribal member death due to Covid.

Table 2 shows the total cumulative tests and results by entity. For Employee, School and Urban Member surveillance testing with Steward Health Care, total tests completed is 83,806 with 779 positive cases with an overall percent positive rate of 1%. The positive case count for surveillance testing includes retests.

Within the appendices, test results are provided for each of the entities tested thru Steward Health Care. As of this report, the Community completed 151,208 tests with a percent positive rate of 3.6%.

Tribal Health has been working with the Taskforce to review other mitigation efforts to slow the spread of the virus. For example, sending several messaging campaigns to the Community strongly urging residents and employees to stay home and only leave your home for essential needs or work. And encouraging all individuals to refrain from traveling and holding any in-person gatherings regardless of the size of the group such as family gatherings, meetings, church services, sport activities. Gatherings and travel increases your chance of getting and spreading Covid. Staying home is the best way to protect yourself and others.

Figure A. Tribal Health Department COVID-19 Daily Data Report

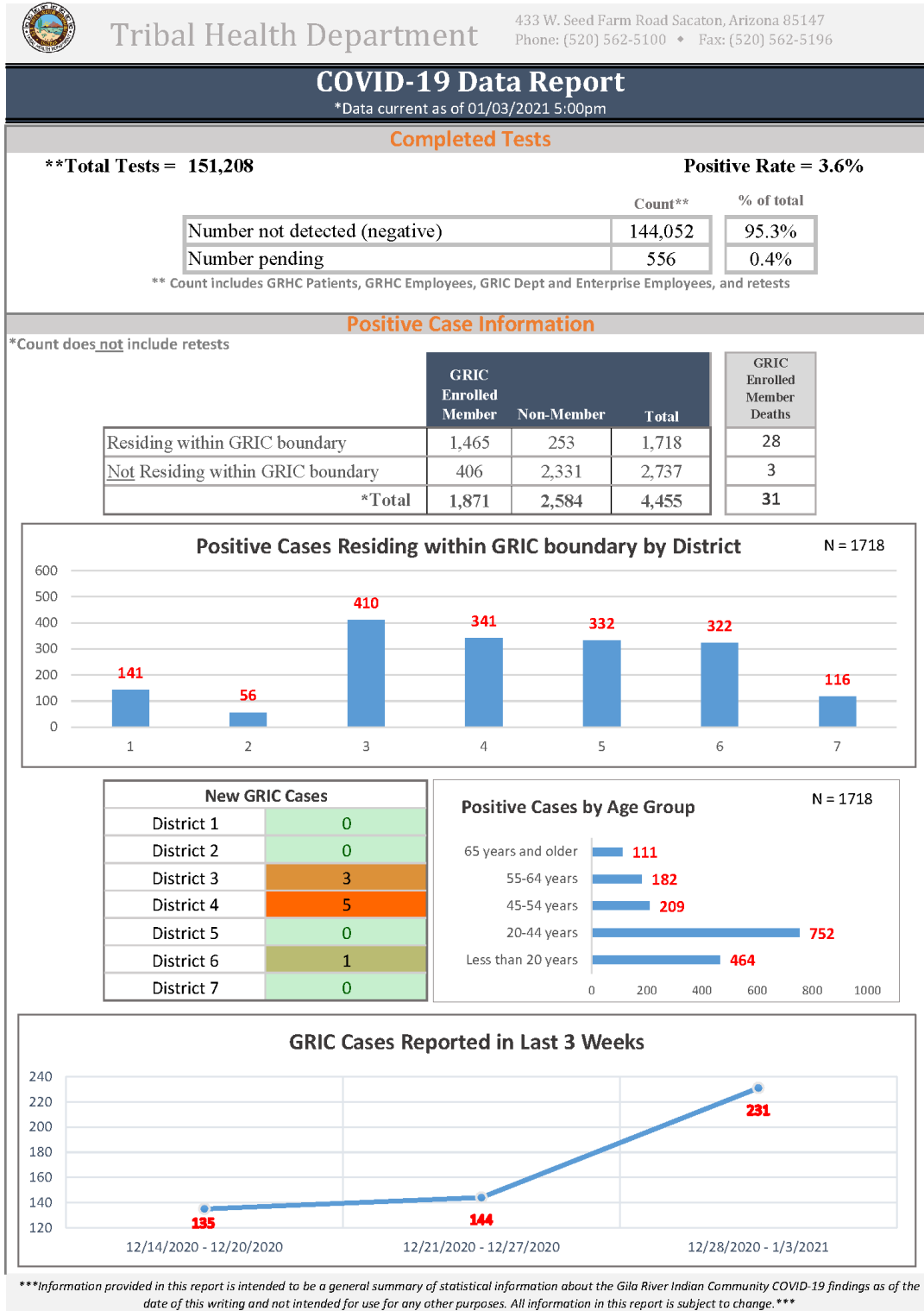
