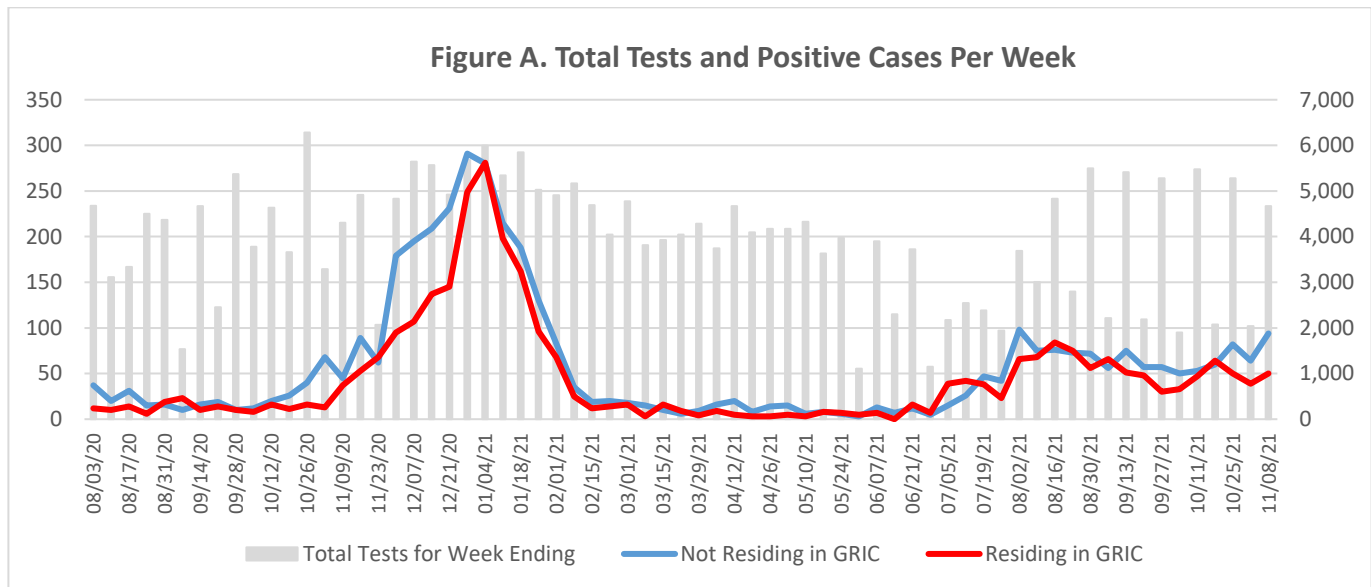

The Tribal Health Department’s data report provides the rate of positive cases for those residing on and off the Community.

- Since March 2020, 42% of the total cases reside in the GRIC boundaries; and 47% are GRIC tribal enrolled members residing on or off the Community boundaries.
- From 10/18/2021 to 11/14/2021, the Community completed 14,056 COVID-19 tests. There was a total of 503 positive cases reported to the Tribal Health Department. Of the 503 positive cases, 203 or 40% of the cases reside in the Community boundaries. The overall percent test positivity rate for cases residing in the Community was 1.4% during this timeframe. Of the total 503 cases, 45% were GRIC tribal enrolled members and 80% were unvaccinated. Of the total GRIC resident cases, 22% were between the age of 0-11 years, 23% between 3-13 years, and 9% between 14-19 years.
- Reviewing the last 4 week for cases residing in GRIC, week 10/18/21 total is 64, week 10/25/21 equals 50, week 11/1/21 at 39 and 11/8/21 weekly total at 50. There was an increase of 11 cases from week 11/1/21 to week 11/8/21. The percent test positivity rate in the last two weeks is at 1.3%. Figure A shows the positive cases are approximately three times higher than the same time last year. The same trend is shown for local counties and the state.

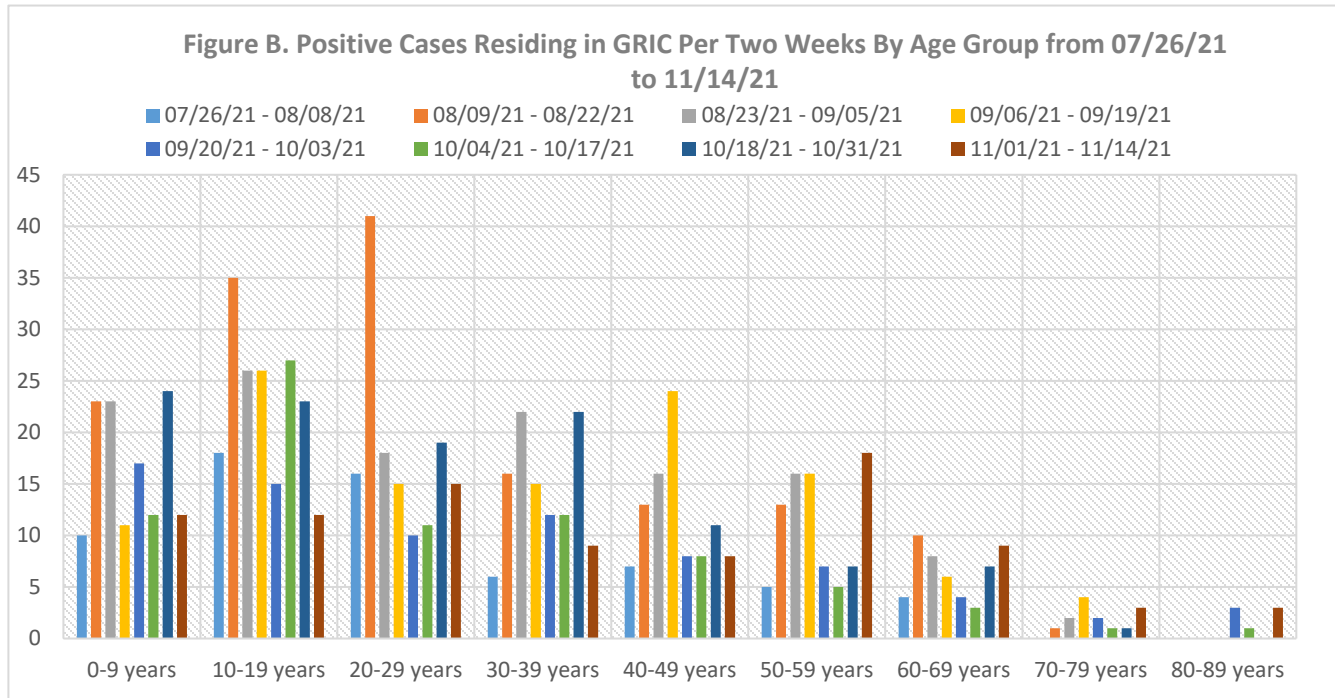


Cases Residing in GRIC: Table 1 provides the number of positive cases by District. During this timeframe, District 4 had the largest rate at 22% of the total resident case. There was an increase of 36 cases since the last report

Figure B provides the positive cases by age group since 07/26/2021 in two week (14 day) intervals. The age group largely affected is the 10-19 year olds at 23% of the total cases residing in GRIC. In the last four weeks, the 10-19 year olds (26% of total) also had largest increase. Subsequently, 0-9 years at 18% and 30-39 year olds at 17%.



The ages most affected continues to be the 7, 11, 12, 14, and 16 year olds. The last 3 months show from August to October all ages were affected.

The table below shows the cumulative cases per District. District 5 has the largest percentage affected at 31% of their total District population. The overall percent population affected for GRIC is now at 28% which is an increase of 1% from the last report. Two additional GRIC tribal enrolled members passed during the last two weeks which is now at 100. The number of positive cases residing in GRIC under quarantine is 80 cases.

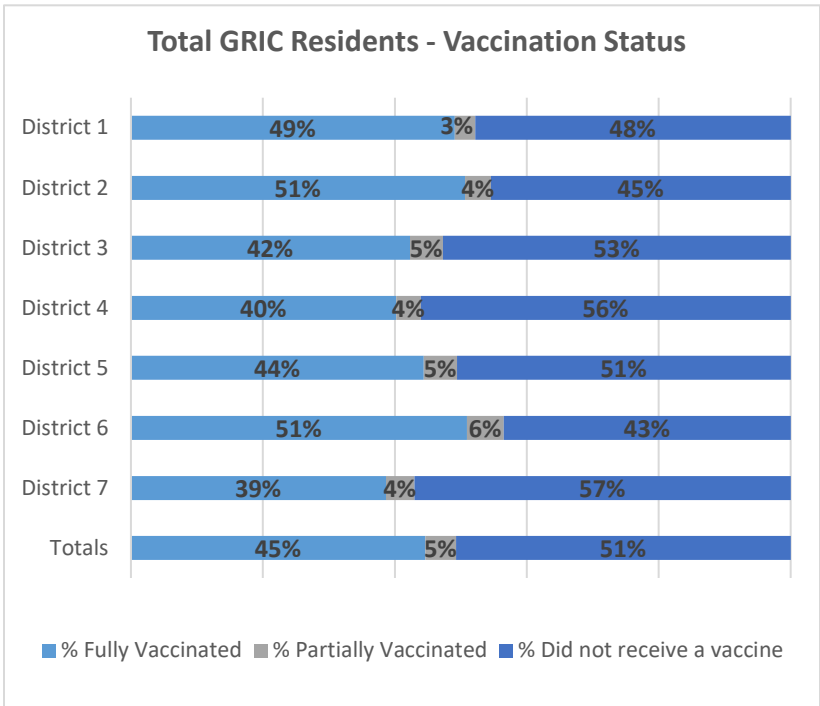
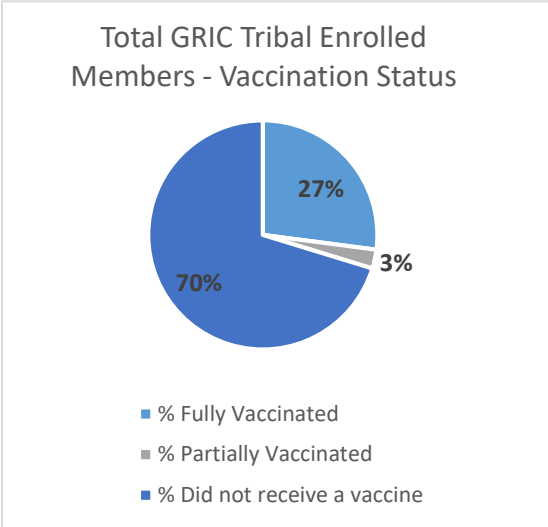

Total employee and urban member surveillance tests completed with Steward Health Care is 171,057 with 1,157 positive cases reported. Test results thru Steward Health Care are provided within the appendices for year 2021. Total tests completed for the Community is 324, 686 which is an increase of 7,605 tests from the last report. The current cumulative percent positive rate remains at 3.4%.

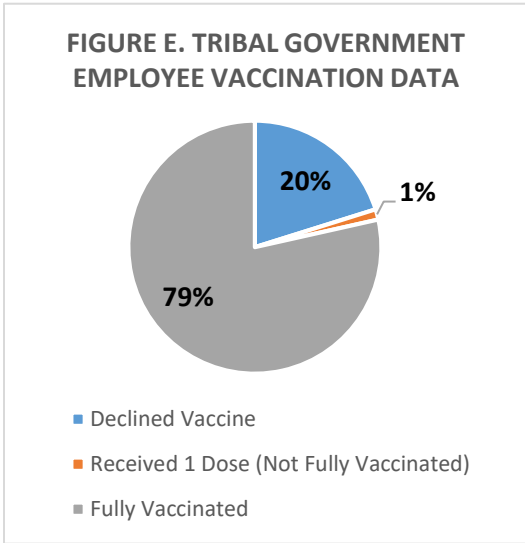
Contact Tracing: In the Community, in the last month, on average a positive case has at least 5 close contacts. This means for 1 positive case there is potentially 5 individuals that may have contracted the virus and could spread to others. Contact tracing continues to show that individuals are contracting and transmitting the virus mostly through family gatherings. In these past two weeks, individuals have noted attending family gatherings, wedding, out of town visits, and one individual noting attended a concert outside the community. The Taskforce will continue to message to the Community about the high risk of contracting the virus and how easily it is spread in gatherings. Individuals should continue to follow all prevention measures such as staying home as much as possible, wearing a face mask, washing your hands frequently, using hand sanitizer, physically distancing and getting vaccinated.

Vaccination Updates: GRIC Tribal Enrolled Members and Individuals Residing in GRIC

Currently of the GRIC Tribal enrolled members that are 5 years and older – 28% have been fully vaccinated. Of the total GRIC Tribal Enrolled members 27% have been fully vaccinated. This percentage accounts for GRIC tribal enrolled members residing on or off the Community boundaries. Of the GRIC residents that are 5 years and older – 47% have been fully vaccinated. Of the total GRIC residents (includes all ages) 45% have been fully vaccinated. This percentage accounts for non-GRIC tribal enrolled members residing in the community. The Health Department is working with the GRIC Enrollment and Census Department to update the data counts if required.



Vaccination Updates: GRIC Tribal Government Employees



The current count of number of employees is 1,820. Figure E shows 79% of the tribal government employees are fully vaccinated. The breakdown for each category is as follows: 79% (1,434) are fully vaccinated, 20% (362) declined the vaccine, and 1% (24) received at least 1 dose of the vaccine. Vaccination data per Department can be found in the appendices.

COVID-19 vaccinations have been increasing steadily in the last few weeks in the community which is good news. Gila River Health Care continues to work with the Taskforce to provide vaccine opportunities. Since the approval of 5 to 11 year old vaccine eligibility, we have seen an increase in children vaccinations. As of 11/16/21, 118 children received their first dose of the Pfizer vaccine. We are optimistic we will continue to see more children receive their first dose and eventually become fully vaccinated. We must continue to work towards vaccinating eligible Community members and employees.
